2. 1,333 shares of the reported Common Stock are Restricted Shares. The Restrictions lapse in accordance with the following schedule- 1/2 vest on 7/1/2017, 1/2 vest on 7/1/2018. 7. Options to purchase shares of Common Stock are subject to the following vesting schedule- 1/5 vest on 7-1/2015, 1/5 vest on 7-1/2016, 1/5 vest on 7-1/2017, 1/5 vest on 7-1/2018 and 1/5 vest on 7-1/2019. Options expire 7 years from grant date.
